### **Pedaling Against AIDS** **From High Point to Cape May**

**MILLVILLE, NJ**—Dozens of bicyclists from all around New Jersey were pedaling to raise awareness about AIDS during the seventh annual New Jersey Ride Against AIDS (NJRAA) held this past weekend from Friday, September 26 through Sunday, September 28, 2007.

This year Javier Gonzalez, who works as South Jersey AIDS Alliance's transportation coordinator from its Cape May County site, committed to riding and finishing the grueling 250-mile bicycle ride from High Point to Cape May—from the northwest corner to the southeast tip of the state of New Jersey. No easy mission, no more worthwhile cause.

“Once again our group of concerned New Jersey residents got together and accomplished something extraordinary. While training hard, they also raised at least \$65,000,” reported a NJRAA spokesperson. Over \$340,000 has been raised by the NJRAA since 2002. 100% of the money raised is donated to nine New Jersey AIDS non-profit organizations including the South Jersey AIDS Alliance serving Cumberland, Cape May and Atlantic counties.
